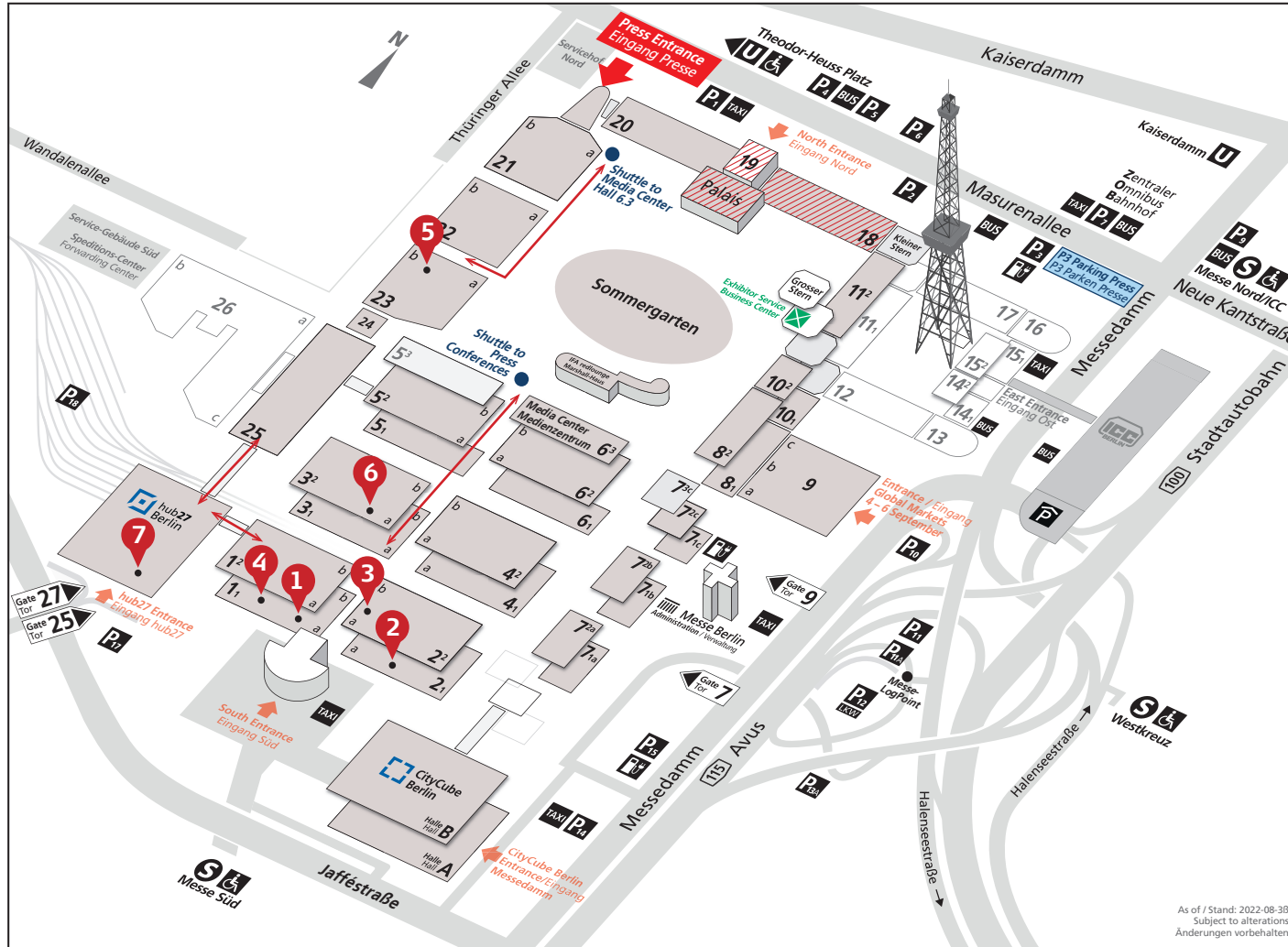

 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Danger of injury to feet by nails, screws, bolts etc. lying around on the floor and other surfaces. • Danger of injury from material (e. g. as used in stand construction), tools and suspended loads falling from a height. • Danger of slipping and falling due to soiled hall floors, open floor channels, unsecured cables, pipes and other material. • Danger of tripping over materials that have been placed on the floor. • Danger of accidents due to forklift traffic and transport vehicles.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please avoid areas where assembly or disassembly work is taking place if an alternative route is available • Please take every caution since material is being moved all the time • Never walk or stand beneath suspended and hoisted loads that have not been properly secured. • Please pay attention to the safety signs and markings (advisory, prohibition and warning signs) in the respective work area.
